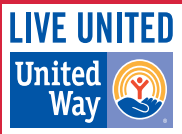

## What is the Weatherization Program?

The Weatherization Assistance Program provides free home energy conservation services to low-income Michigan homeowners and renters. Services reduce energy use and lower utility bills.

**Availability:** Barry, Branch, Calhoun, St. Joseph, and Kalamazoo Counties

**Your energy bills could be cut by 30% or more!**

Services can include:

- Wall Insulation
- Attic Insulation and Ventilation
- Foundation Insulation
- Air Leakage Reduction
- Smoke Detectors
- Dryer Venting

The Weatherization Program is not a Home Rehabilitation Program. Some conditions of a home may disqualify your home for the Weatherization Program.



## Income requirements

Eligibility is based on household income being at or below 200 percent of the federal poverty guidelines. If you receive cash assistance administered by the department of Human Services you automatically qualify for this no-cost program.
